

When you see the letter E at the end of a word it is always doing an important job. Sometimes it is even doing two jobs.

1. Match the job to the symbol-

Sometimes the E is part of a split digraph. It is jumping backwards and making the short vowel shout its name.



Sometimes the E is throwing magic dust and melting C and G. It is making them say their soft sounds /s/ and /j/.

Sometimes the E is policing V. The letter V is never ever allowed at the end of a word.

Sometimes the E is making sure we know a word is not a plural. We use it after S and Z sounds.

2. Sound button these words and then circle the job(s) the final E is doing. Remember that the final E doesn't have a sound button of its own as it isn't making its own sound.

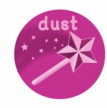

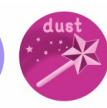

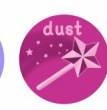
